The mission of TCCC is to make a difference in our lives, improve the lives of others, and to positively change the environment of the communities we are serving.

The AmeriCorps Hoopa Tribal CCC Vision

The vision of the TCCC is to add hope to the future of our youth leaders, to heal the communities, which we reside, and to restore balance to our natural environment.

Experiences – Opportunities – Results

While at TCCC, participants will become members of the Hoopa Valley community, they will also travel and learn to adapt to other communities, creating positive change. TCCC offers a variety of experiences. Corps Members receive the opportunity to learn valuable job skills while traveling, and working in a team-based atmosphere. They will be assigned to a team of 8-12 other corps members, to create a solid working relationship. Due to the size of the program, (36) participants become each other's support system during their service. They will room with one other room mate during their stay here at Hoopa-TCCC. *Results vary with each corps members- but most enhance their skills in education; learn important values like cooperation, teamwork, ambition, self-discipline; and develop into active citizens who will make a difference in our Native communities, and across the Nation.*

Eligibility Requirements

- Young Men/Women (18-24)
- Preference Given to Native AmeriCans
- Drug & Alcohol Free Upon Entry & Test Randomly Thereafter
- Sign a contract to serve 1700 hours
- Must Live in TCCC Dorms on the Hoopa Indian Reservation
- Be Able to Travel on projects 4-6 Weeks
- Willing to work long hours & take on new challenges

Benefits

- Room and Board Provided at no cost
- \$250 BiWeekly Living Stipend
- Child Care Benefits May be eligible for full child care benefits with dependent children
- Receive a \$5,730 Educational Award Upon Successful Completion
